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To enhance your **EYESEE experience** and **ensure continuous improvement**, we have integrated new features and carried out updates within the EYESEE Cloud application.

The improvements included in the release of version 1.25 for March 2026 are as follows.

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1. Users

— Upgrade

✓ **Password change notifications** : You will now receive a confirmation email every time your password is updated.

2. Faces

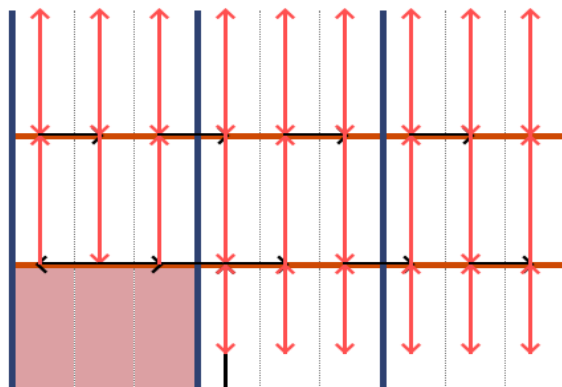
— Upgrade

✓ **Improved navigation flow in mission previews**: Navigation arrows now consistently move from left to right, regardless of the actual mission execution path.



— New features

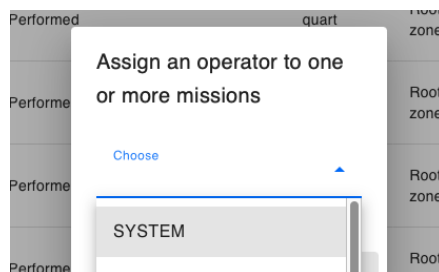
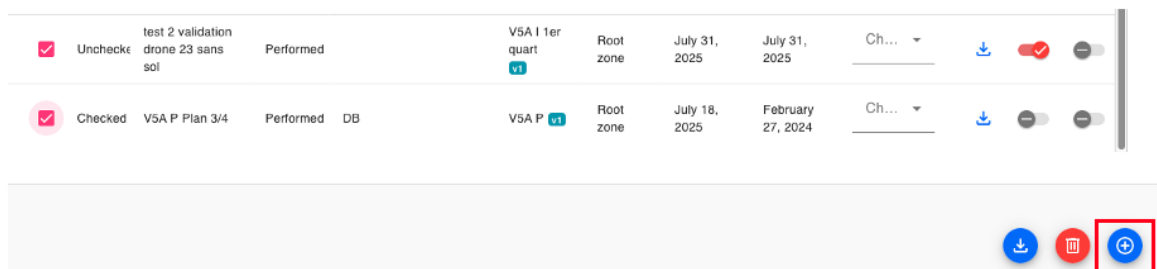
✓ **Mission generation starting over a « Flight prohibited » zone**: It is now possible to generate a mission where the starting point is located above a restricted zone. In this case, the drone will not take off from within the zone, but from a nearby authorized position. It will then perform progressive maneuvers until it reaches the mission's first valid waypoint.



However, a mission cannot start and end within the same « Flight prohibited » zone. For example:



✓ **Assignment of missions to operators:** To facilitate mission execution, users with Trainor or Manager roles (Customer and Warehouse) are authorized to assign missions to other users.



This feature allows operators to view only the missions assigned to them, as well as any unassigned missions, directly from their tablets.

✓ **Standardized separator for execution reports:** The separator defined in user preferences (comma or semicolon), already used for expected values files, is now also applied to execution reports.

✓ **Unique code validation for acquisitions:** During file imports, if the acquisition settings require unique codes, the system now verifies that every code is distinct. If any duplicates are detected, an error will be triggered and mission creation will be blocked.

Errors in the file

- Column SSCC: The code(s): 1234 appear multiple times even though the "unique code" option was checked for this acquisition.

3. Warehouse View

— Upgrade

✓ **Warehouse picking zone correction:** Previously, certain faces were unable to hit 100% completion due to picking zone inclusion.

For users without handheld readers, picking zones are now marked as non-inventoriable. Consequently, faces can now achieve full completion status based exclusively on drone-performed missions.

— New features

✓ **Select all zones:** In the warehouse view, users can now select all zones in a single action.

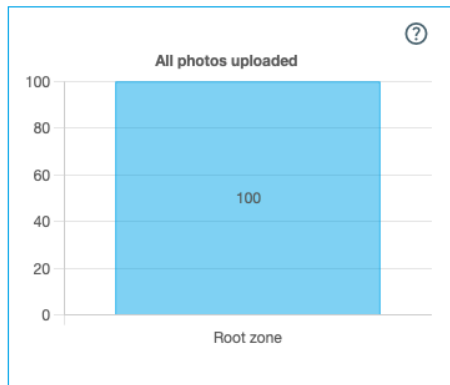
✓ **Open mission in a new tab:** Previously, it was not possible to open a rack face mission from the warehouse view in a separate tab. You can now do so by right-clicking on the mission on the right.

4. Dashboard

— New features

✓ **Photo upload tracking chart:** The dashboard now includes a chart comparing actual vs. expected photo counts for all missions within a selected timeframe.

Note: This functionality is only available for missions executed following this release.



5. API

— New features

✓ For clients who request it, **an API** can be enabled to allow WMS to communicate directly with Eyesee Cloud. Currently, available features include creating inventories and retrieving values recorded during inventory missions.
